Around 270,000 children are estimated to be having an NSBP breakfast on an average school day \*

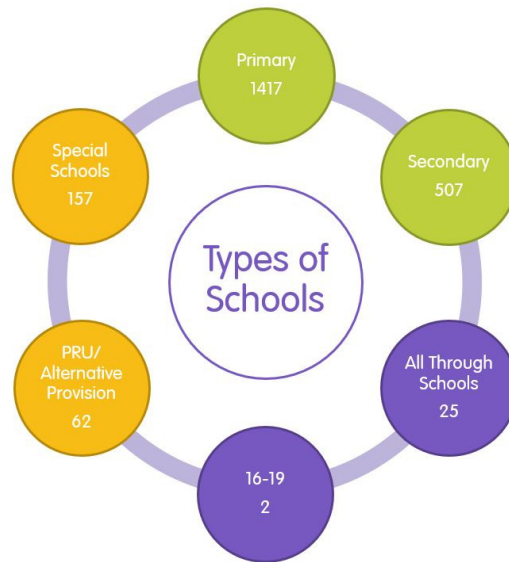
## 110,000
