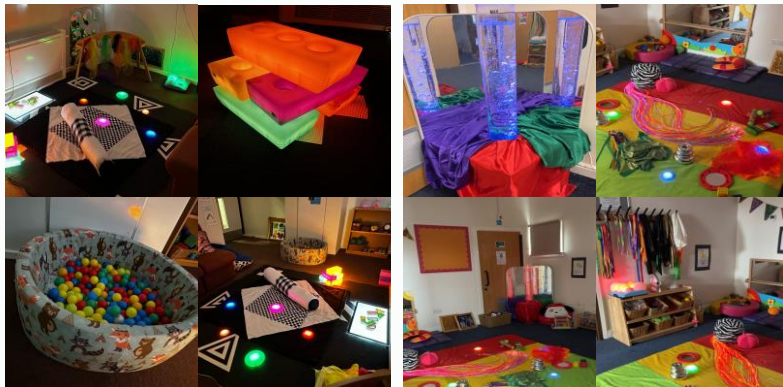
The Solihull Approach is for parents who want to understand their child's behaviour better. It is also a chance to meet with other parents experiencing the same challenges.

1-1 With Families

This service helps the development of children ages 0-4 years with a delay in two or more areas of their development. This delay may be due to a diagnosed condition, but no formal diagnosis is required for a referral.



Let's Connect

Let's Connect is for children who may need additional support in a range of areas, now or in the future. For example communication, participation, education & behavior. Let's Connect is for children under five years.

Let's Get Talking

Let's Get Talking is a program designed to support parents/carers to better understand how to encourage and support their child to communicate; and give them strategies to practice. The group is delivered in collaboration with the Speech & Language Therapy Team.

MAXability

The group is aimed at families with children under the age of five who have any sort of Special Educational Need or disability, and can be a great source of fun and support for both the children and the parents that attend. Sessions provide children the opportunity to access the sensory room as well as the soft play area, two safe environments that they can explore in their own way with parents and staff close by when needed.
