SEND is a short way of saying
SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS
and
DISABILTIES

Do you have a Special Educational Need (SEN)?

You may have SEN if you need extra help & support to do things at school/college. It could be the work is difficult but it could also be that you struggle with your independence or social skills or the setting makes it hard to learn. You can have SEN without having a disability.



Do you have a disability?

You do not always have to have a diagnosis. If you have had a physical or mental health difficulty for a long time, this may be classed as a disability.



Some examples of disabilities are anxiety, autism, downs syndrome, ADHD & dyspraxia.
