Over 162,000 pupil premium children are estimated to be having an NSBP breakfast on an average school day *

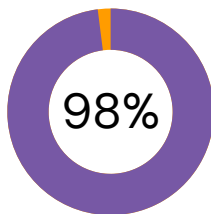
