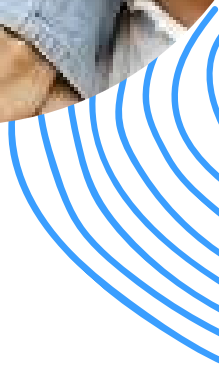

What to do if you are unhappy with us

If you are unhappy with PAC UK, you can:

- tell your parent or carer what you are unhappy about, and/or
- tell the counsellors who are working with you, or another adult at PAC-UK.

If you are very upset and unhappy about something at PAC-UK you can make a formal complaint.
