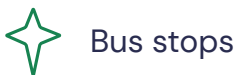
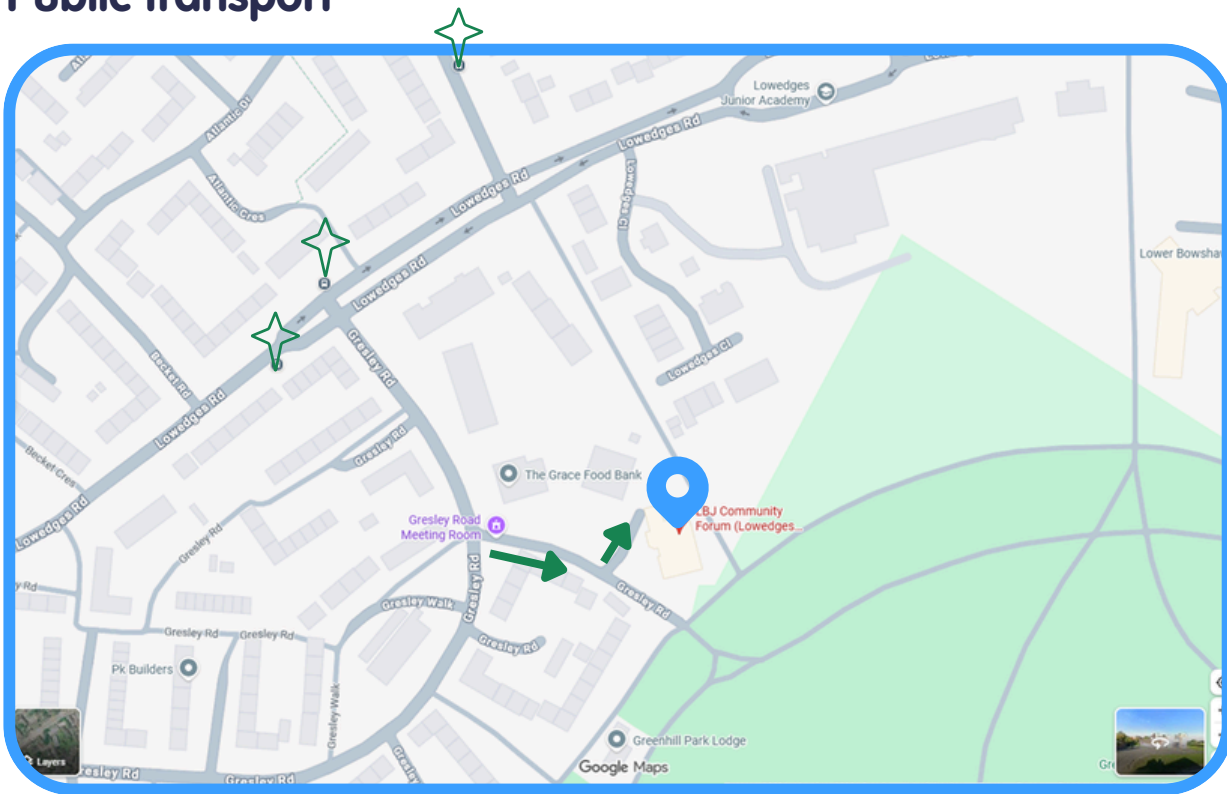




Lowedges Community Centre - Accessibility

Parking

- Limited free on-site parking.

The reception desk is straight ahead.

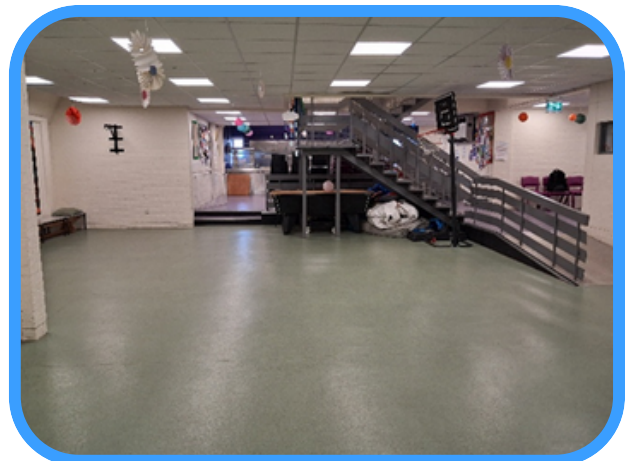
Please sign in at the reception desk.

We use the main hall visible from the reception desk – on the right as you look at the desk.

Details of rooms

Main hall

- Smooth even floor throughout.
- Steps and ramp between reception and room.
- Large open space, can be noisy, but space to move apart.
- Overhead lighting (movement sensitive).
- Limited natural light.
- Quiet pod is available.



Things to note:

- Disabled toilet on same level as the community room.
- Male toilet on same level as the community room.
- Female toilets on same level as reception/kitchen.
- Baby change available in the disabled toilet.
- Welcome to breast feed.
- Tea/coffee/hot chocolate available. Dairy milk and oat milk available. **Please ask any member of staff/volunteer at the event and they will make you one.**
- Kitchen is for staff only.
- Fidgets are available to use during the event.
- No hearing loop available.
