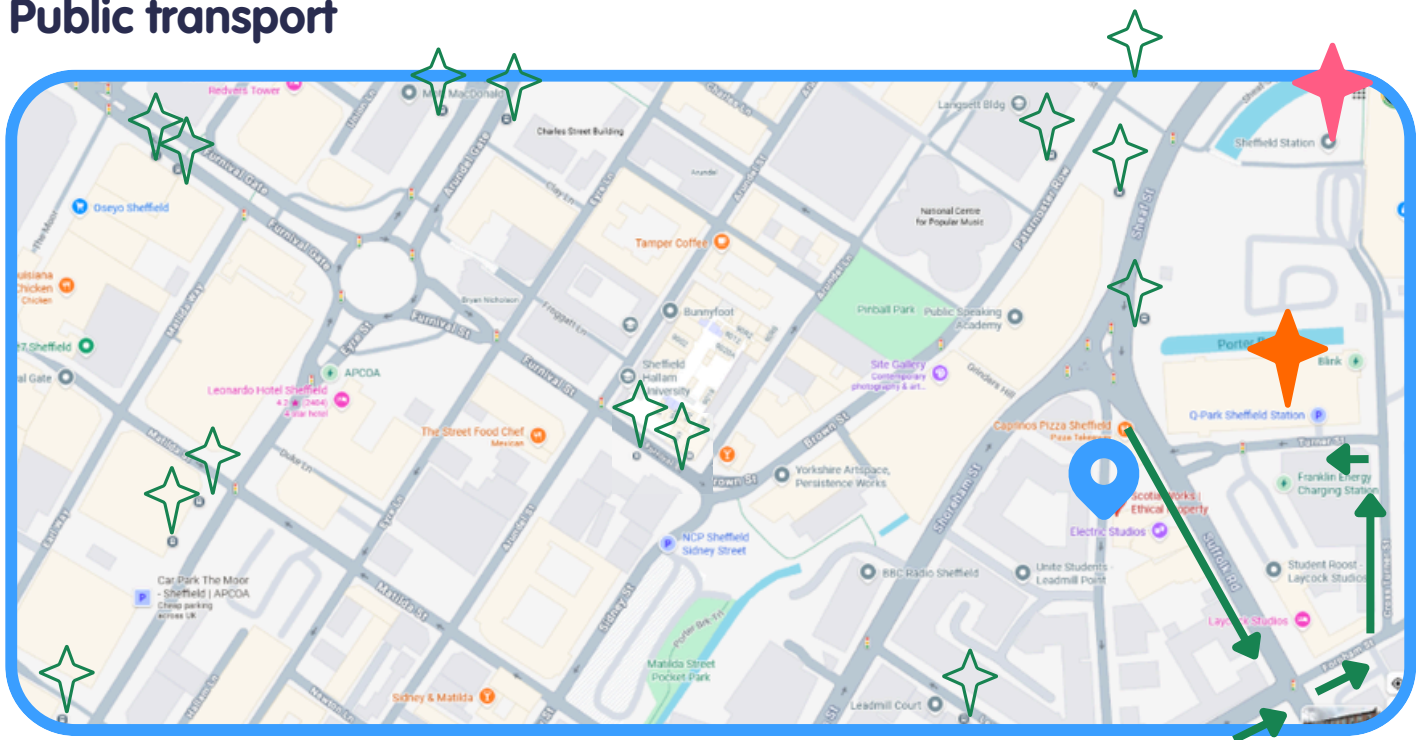




# Scotia Works - Accessibility

## Getting here

### Public transport

## Parking

### Leadmill Road

- One way street.
- Limited on street parking – pay using ‘Pay by Phone’ app or at a machine.
- Double yellow lines – blue badge parking may be possible.
- Dropped curbs on both sides in certain places.

### Q-Park Turner Street (train station car park)

- Indicated on the map above = 
- One way system to enter. See green arrows on the map above.
- Disabled parking, parent and child parking, EV charging.

# Entering the building

The main door is blue with glass panes.

Red sign above the door with "Scotia Works" in white letters.

Silver intercom to the left of the door (sign on the door with instructions for the intercom).

On the intercom, press 2 then the green bell.

Someone will come to the door to let you in.

The entrance door is push from the outside. It is heavy. The person letting you in can pull the door open.

The person letting you in will take you into the lift to floor -1 or through the pull door and down some steps.

There is a pull door to enter the Atrium.



# Details of rooms



## Atrium

- Slightly uneven flagstone floor (with recessed flowerbed).
- Lots of natural light from high, glass vaulted ceiling.
- Very warm in summer/sun, very cool in winter.
- Echoes.

## Training room

- Double doors on the right.
- Carpeted even floor.
- No windows, little natural light.
- Can get noisy.



## Meeting room

- Last door on the left.
- Carpeted even floor.
- Some natural light.
- Used as a quiet room.



## Things to note:

- Disabled toilet on same level as the Atrium.
- 3 unisex toilets on same level as the Atrium.
- Baby change facilities available.
- Welcome to breast feed.
- Tea/coffee/hot chocolate available in the Atrium. Dairy milk and oat milk available.
- The kitchen is for staff only.
- Fidgets are available to use during the event.
- No hearing loop available.
